Multi-Agency Webinar: Trauma Informed Practice

Background Information

Safeguarding Webinars: Just in case you missed one of our safeguarding training events we took the opportunity to record them to create a library of safeguarding webinars.

Each webinar provides practitioners from all partner agencies the chance to watch a pre-recorded session and ask questions.

Trauma Informed Practice: A strength- based service delivery approach "that is grounded in an understanding of and responsiveness to the impact of trauma, that emphasises physical, psychological and emotional safety for both workers and survivors, and that builds opportunities for survivors to rebuild a sense of control and empowerment" (Hopper, Bassuk & Olivet 2010). It involves awareness in anticipating and avoiding processes and practices that are likely to re-traumatise individuals who have histories of trauma. Trauma informed practice is grounded in compassion and empathy.

Webinar Aims

This course aims to raise awareness of the impact of Trauma and increase knowledge of the benefits of Trauma Informed Practice.

Webinar Objectives

By the end of the session you will have had the opportunity to:

- Familiarise yourself with the definition of trauma
- Increase your knowledge related to the impacts of trauma on the body and brain
- Increase awareness of the principles of Trauma Informed Practice
- Increase awareness of ways of working and practical strategies to support people who have experienced traumatic events.
